

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ST. CLAIR Accessibility Advisory Committee

Requires Three Committee Members

The Township of St. Clair is seeking three community members to join the Accessibility Advisory Committee. The community members must be a person living with a disability.

The Accessibility Advisory Committee meets once per year but may meet more as needed; and members will be compensated for mileage and per diem.

The main purpose and of the Accessibility Advisory Committee is to:

- Advise Township Council on the preparation, implementation and effectiveness of its multi-year accessibility plan.
- Advise Township Council on other accessibility related issues within the Township.

Applicants must be over 18 years of age. As per the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, a majority of the committee members shall be people living with a disability. The Committee is currently made up of one councillor, two members of staff, and member from the community.
